### Detail

The Master of Information Technology is a postgraduate degree consisting of 96 units of credit. It is taught in English and normally takes two years of full-time study, or part-time equivalent. The program structure requires the successful completion of compulsory and elective courses. This qualification is located at Level 9 of the Australian Qualifications Framework.

Candidates for admission require a Bachelor degree in the relevant discipline, or other approved equivalent academic and professional qualifications.

This program provides students with no, or minimal prior computing background, with a broad-based information technology education, and more specialised knowledge in up to two areas, enabling them to work in a range of positions in the information technology industry.

### Pathway to further study

Graduates have access to a range of Graduate Certificates, Graduate Diplomas and Masters degrees.


### Program accreditation
